**Volunteer in CYS Programs (CDC, FCC, SAS, MS/T, Sports,
SKIESUNLIMITED, Outreach Services)**

- A. Serve as a *Month of the Military Child* Event Helper, some ideas may be:
 - Take photos during a *CYS Month of the Military Child* Event – (CYS will provide you with the digital camera, etc.)
 - Video tape an event
 - Assist with a Volksmarch
- B. Bring a parent who has never used CYS to the Central Enrollment Registration office and assist them with registration
- C. Bring a new parent who has never used the Army Family Covenant Program to the CYS AFC programs – share the Army Family Covenant CYS Programs with the parents, - what is available!?!)
- D. Be a Parent/Child/Youth Greeter – for 1-3 mornings during *Month of the Military Child* - assist parents with helping to get their children out of the car and into the CDC, assist the classrooms staff in preparing the children/youth for school and help the children get on the bus, etc.
- E. Recruit a spouse to be an FCC Provider
- F. Place a book on tape for the library corner
- G. Read a story to the children during story time – perhaps your favorite story when you were a child
- H. Assist with a Promise Passport Youth Volunteer activity
- I. Help during a meal time: i.e. with hand washing, family style dining, meal time conversations, clean up, etc.
- J. Assist with setting up room displays or bulletin boards

- K. Be a nap time helper – nap time is a busy time so assist staff in settling children down, reading stories and helping children to relax.
 - L. Field trip assistant – attend a field trip as a parent helper
 - M. Technology Lab– Assist the Technology Lab Teacher by helping youth with software, computer projects, homework assistance, etc.
 - N. Homework Lab - Assist the Homework Lab Teacher by providing homework assistance, etc.
 - O. Assist a coach during a sporting event, be a scorekeeper, help pass out or collect equipment during the game, officiate a game, etc.
 - P. Volunteer to Coach a sport
 - Q. Volunteer to teach a *SKIESUNLIMITED* Class
 - R. Serve as a Room Parent
 - S. Share an ethnic tradition with your child's class or program, i.e. teach school age children a traditional dance or a traditional song.
 - T. Label shelves in your child's classroom
 - U. Assist with painting a room, cleaning out a closet, or rearranging a classroom.
 - V. Play an outdoor game – teach children/youth a new game or assist the classroom staff in playing outdoor games
 - W. Volunteer to assist with a Parent Advisory Board event
 - X. Serve as an officer on the Parent Advisory Board
 - Y. Provide an original article, recipe, story, etc. for the CYS Parent Newsletter
 - Z. Chaperone a Youth Event at the Middle School/Teen Center
